This is a fun way to help children remember the Lord's Prayer. Teach these actions. See how quickly they can remember each of the actions.

Our Father in heaven,	(point up)
hallowed be your name,	(cup hands)
your kingdom come	(motion 'come here')
your will be done,	(point up to heaven)
on earth as in heaven.	(point down to ground)
Give us today	(open hands outward)
our daily bread.	(cross hands to shoulders)
Forgive us our sins	(praying hands)
as we forgive those	(hands on heart)
who sin against us.	(hands open to others)
Lead us not into temptation,	(arms out-stretched to heaven)
but deliver us from evil.	(push palms downwards)
For the kingdom,	(make one muscle arm)
the power,	(make other muscle arm)
and the glory are yours	(hands waving down)
now and forever. Amen.	(folded prayer hands)
