DISAPPEARING SIN ACTIVITY

God sent Jesus into the world to forgive the sins of all people. Jesus did this through his death on the cross. He took the punishment for our sins. This is the good news of Easter for all people.

YOU WILL NEED

- Paper towel
- 1 black permanent marker
- Washable markers
- Water in flat container (to fit paper towel)

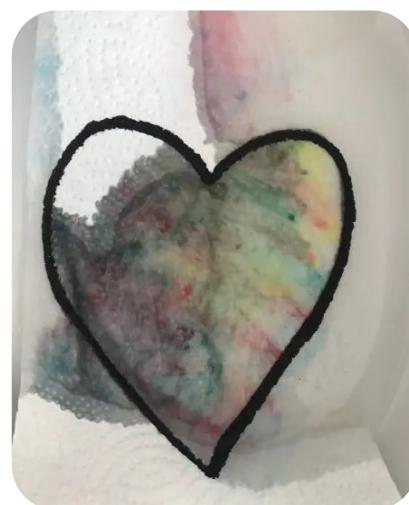
WHAT TO DO

1. Fold the paper towel in half.
2. Using a permanent marker, draw a heart shape on the top layer.
3. Scribble on the bottom later with washable markers.

This picture is like our heart. We like to pretend that it's all nice and clean inside, like this white paper towel. But underneath, it's really all messy with sin. Sin is all the not so good things that I do, say and think about others or ourselves and gets in the way of being friends with Jesus.

4. Drop the paper towel in a small flat container of water. The water-colour will initially show through the front of the heart but eventually wash out of the paper towel!

Jesus sees all the messy sin. But when we ask for forgiveness, he washes the messiness away and leaves us with a clean heart. We need to keep asking Jesus to forgive the wrong things that we do, over and over again and Jesus forgives us over and over again too!
